

**MINUTES**  
**SPECIAL BOARD MEETING**  
**WESTERN ELMORE COUNTY RECREATION DISTRICT (WECRD)**

**I. CALL MEETING TO ORDER/ ESTABLISH QUORUM**

Director Dan Gillies called the meeting to order at 6:02PM, and a quorum was established with President, Dan Gillies, Vice-President, Lee Pierce (via phone), and Director, Doug Meyer all present.

**II. NEW BUSINESS**

There was discussion about using a metal, prefabricated building for the pool project. The concerns with this type of building are as follows: occupancy requirements which have to have a certain level of design for doors, the overall number of doors in the building, fire codes, energy codes for insulation, furnace size, International Building Codes (IBC), door widths, parking, International Plumbing Codes, NFPA codes, etc. The expert advice WECRD will receive from LCA architects is why we hired them for the design phase. Administrator, Michelle Heins spoke with the architect about the prefabricated building, and they are already exploring the option of using that type of building for the project. The board understands the option of having a metal building but would prefer the help from an architect to make sure it is built properly and follows all the various codes.

LCA Architects will be prepared to show WECRD the pool options in about two weeks.

**III. GENERAL DISCUSSION**

Little discussion was held regarding Railroad Park. WECRD is waiting on the City of Mountain Home to make a decision about buying the park.
