

Hello APRIL!

We're feeling energized as we move into the next phase of the project. The CMU and reinforced steel were ordered at the end of March and has an eight-week lead time, giving the contractors ample opportunity to prepare the site and coordinate schedules with the electrical and plumbing work that will take place simultaneously. They will also begin the utility coordination for temporary set up as they await the CMU arrival.

Over the next six months, this phase will cover some of the major elements of the construction process, including installing interior walls and ceilings, completing plumbing and electrical rough-ins, and fitting doors, frames, hardware, glazing, fire sprinklers, and all fixtures—such as showers, sinks, and toilets—to ensure the facility is fully functional at completion.

The Recreation Foundation remains a strong supporter behind the progress of the Aquatic Center—actively championing the project and pursuing additional funding through grants and community donations.
